Welcome to Vietnam & Cambodia!

Discover the contrasts of Vietnam and Cambodia through a journey shaped by heritage, landscapes, and local culture. From Hanoi's historic charm and the limestone scenery of Ha Long Bay to lantern-lit Hoi An, the Mekong Delta, and the ancient temples of Angkor, the itinerary combines cultural discovery, nature, and authentic regional experiences across two iconic Southeast Asian destinations.

Vietnam

- **Population:** Vietnam is home to over 97 million people, making it the 15th most populous country in the world.
- **Capital:** The capital city of Vietnam is Hanoi, known for its rich history, French colonial architecture, and vibrant street life.
- **Language:** The official language is Vietnamese, but English is increasingly spoken, especially in urban areas.
- **Currency:** The official currency is the Vietnamese Dong (VND). ATMs are widely available in big cities, and major credit cards are accepted in many establishments. It's advisable to carry some cash in dong for small purchases.
- **Cultural Etiquette:** Respect is essential in Vietnamese culture. It's customary to greet others with a slight bow or nod, remove shoes before entering homes or temples, and dress modestly when visiting religious sites.
- **Cuisine:** Vietnamese cuisine is celebrated for its fresh ingredients, complex flavors, and diverse dishes. Some must-try include pho (noodle soup), banh mi (Vietnamese sandwich), and fresh spring rolls.



Cambodia

- **Population:** Cambodia has a population of approximately 17 million people, with a rich cultural heritage rooted in ancient traditions.
- **Capital:** The capital city is Phnom Penh, a dynamic riverside city known for its Royal Palace and bustling markets
- **Language:** Khmer is the official language. English is widely understood in tourist areas, hotels, and among younger Cambodians, especially in urban centers.
- **Currency:** The official currency is the Cambodian Riel (KHR). ATMs are widely available in cities, and major credit cards are accepted in hotels and restaurants. It's recommended to carry some small cash when traveling to rural areas.
- **Cultural Etiquette:** Cambodian culture places a high value on respect and politeness. Visitors should dress modestly, especially when entering temples, and always remove shoes before entering homes or religious buildings.
- **Cuisine:** Must-try dishes include amok (a coconut milk curry steamed in banana leaves), lok lak (stir-fried beef), and nom banh chok (Khmer noodles). Street food is also a delightful part of the local experience.

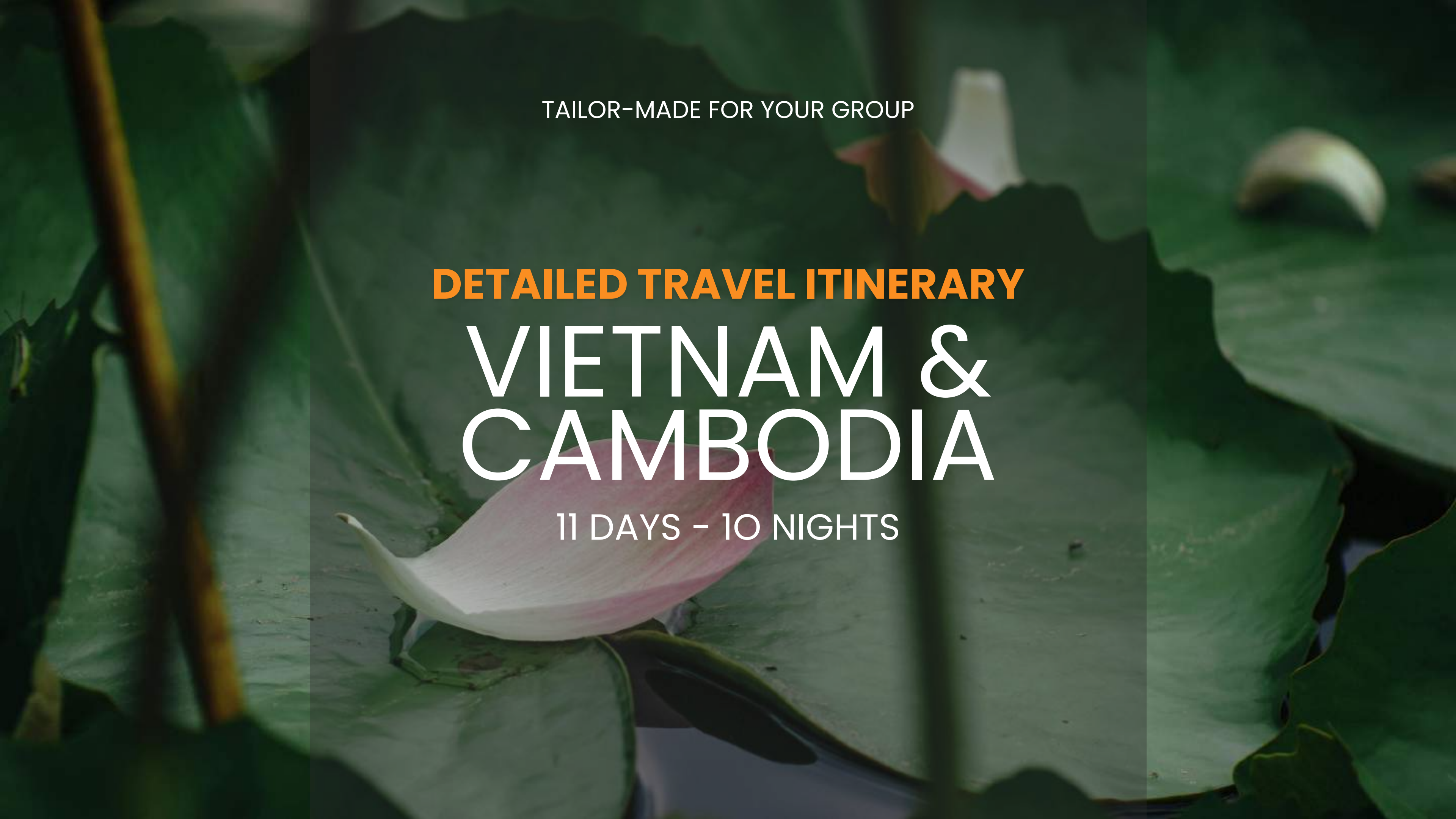
